




- 2 Each result has an availability marker and is labelled as a book, chapter, image, etc.
- 3 Search modifications may be made using the left-hand panel. The search term may be edited, additional filters may be applied, and the search may be narrowed by availability, edition, format, subject, series, publication date/range, and more.

NAVIGATING CONTENT

- 1 Clicking into the content will show the book or chapter with options to download as a PDF, split screen, view citation and permissions, and share.
- 2 Split view provides two independently scrolling panels: the left for the primary text, and the right to easily switch between contents, tables and figures, references, notes, and related material.
- **3** Within figures and tables, options are available to open the image in a new tab or download as a PowerPoint slide.




WHAT ARE SERIES PAGES?



Once a subject is selected and a user is browsing the content, they can apply the same filters to navigate the results as described on page 2.






NAVIGATING AN ARTICLE




